



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

THE UNIVERSITY OF ADELAIDE

AUSTRALIA

and

UNIVERSITY OF CONCEPCION


CHILE

1. The University of Adelaide and the University of Concepcion (Universidad de Concepción) wish to collaborate in order to benefit their research and teaching activities, and to further the internationalisation of both universities.
2. The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to establish a framework within which co-operation may develop between the two institutions. This will occur within the context of the regulations and policies of each university, and subject to the availability of resources.
3. Co-operation between the two universities may include such activities as:
 - Joint research activities
 - Development of graduate level research training opportunities under the scholarship program BECAS CHILE and the agreement between the Chilean Ministry of Education and the University of Adelaide.
 - Exchanges of academic staff
 - Joint quality assurance
 - Exchange of undergraduate students
 - Such other projects for mutual benefit that are agreed upon by both parties
4. Specific programs or activities will be undertaken under this MOU only after the written agreement of both universities. The terms and conditions of the program or activity, including any financial arrangements, shall be set out in a written Agreement signed by the Rector and/or an authorised representative of each university.




5. Both parties shall designate a liaison office for this MOU and for any subordinate agreements under this MOU. For The University of Adelaide, the office shall be the Pro Vice-Chancellor (International). For the University of Concepcion, the liaison office shall be the Office for Institutional and International Affairs.
6. This MOU comes into effect when the last signatory signs. It will remain in effect for a period of 5 years from that date. Not less than six months prior to its expiry, the two universities will review its operation and decide whether or not to renew it. Any such renewal shall be signed by an authorised representative of each university, and may include variations to this MOU.
7. This MOU may be terminated by the written mutual consent of both universities, or by either university giving 60 days written notice to the other university.
8. This MOU places no financial or legal obligations on either of the universities, nor does it create any legal relationship between them.
9. This MOU has been signed in two (2) versions in English, both equally valid, and of which each university has taken one. The University of Concepcion may accompany the signed Agreement with a translated version for internal reference purposes, always recognizing the English version as having legal authority.
